Background

Local Nature Recovery Strategies are a new planning tool to help nature. 48 strategies are being developed across England, each covering the area of about a county.


For the first time, there is a Local Nature Recovery Strategy (LNRS) to cover West Sussex and another LNRS to cover East Sussex and Brighton & Hove. Together, they set out the main principles, priorities and actions for nature's recovery across Sussex.

Over two thousand local people were involved in the development of these Local Nature Recovery Strategies. Now the drafts have been written, we want to give those living and working in Sussex the opportunity let us know if they think we've got them right.

To enable feedback, a six-week public consultation has launched and will close at 11:55 PM on 26 November 2025.

About the consultation

- The LNRS comprises a written 'Statement of Biodiversity Priorities' (split into 4 Parts) and a Local Habitat Map. We recommend people review Parts 1 and 2 of the written LNRS – which have the context and the recommendations though these are long documents. (Part 3 is for species specialists and Part 4 is supporting technical deatil)
- The hub has user guides for the written LNRS and the map, plus FAQs
- To have their say, reviewers fill in a survey (All questions are voluntary). They can also add a comment directly on to the Local Habitat Map.

We are running 3 webinars to walk different audiences through the strategies – how they help us to help nature, how to navigate the docs and map, how to give feedback.

Have your say on new plans to help nature in Sussex!

Two years in the making, and developed with input from over 2,000 local people, groups and organisations, the very first Local Nature Recovery Strategies for Sussex have now been drafted.

A six-week consultation has just launched to give those living and working in West Sussex, East Sussex and Brighton & Hove the chance to share their views on the plans.

The draft strategies build on and support existing nature recovery efforts already underway in Sussex, from large-scale initiatives to grassroots projects. They help us all to understand what nature needs in our local area and provide a tool that will guide our actions to enable the recovery of this most precious resource.

Each strategy contains 7 principles, 24 priorities and over 100 practical actions to help reverse the decline in habitats and species. These range from incentivising the creation of new wildlife-rich spaces, to small everyday actions that anyone can take to encourage wildlife into their gardens.
